### **SUMMARY**

Reporting to both the Coordinator of the Veterans Health Centre (VHC) and Coordinator of Therapy Services, the physiotherapist provides services for residents at the Veterans Memorial Lodge at Broadmead and clients of the Veterans Health Centre. The Physiotherapist (PT) plans, develops, implements and evaluates physical therapy programs and services, communicates in oral and written format residents' and clients' clinical and program needs to the interdisciplinary team and community agencies; performs administrative duties associated with the physical therapy program; oversees the implementation of components of physical therapy care plans and activity programs by therapy assistants, resident care staff, activity workers, and bath assistants. Participation in interdisciplinary team rounds and care conferences is also required.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

#### **Education:**

Graduation from a university with an approved program in Physiotherapy, as well as current registration in good standing, or eligible for registration with the College of Physiotherapists of British Columbia: eligible for membership in the Canadian Physiotherapy Association.

#### **Experience:**

- Experience providing physical therapy services in a long term care and/or community health setting with elderly individuals who have chronic physical and psychosocial disabilities.
- Experience working with an interdisciplinary team.
- Previous experience working with veterans considered an asset.
- Experience working with people with dementia is preferred.

- Competency in organization of workplace; operation of equipment and prioritization and management of duties.
- Effective verbal communication skills with clients of varying levels of cognition, families, and staff.
